You are invited to participate in the FREE (paid for with grant dollars) **Three Simple Rules workshop** (two sessions) scheduled for Monday, October 12, and Thursday, October 15, 6:30-8:30 p.m. in the Lamoni Community Center; teacher: Linda DeBarthe (former tax accountant for KPMG Peat Marwick, Professor of Accounting and Business Administration at Graceland University for 20 years). The workshop focuses on the three simple rules of personal financial management.
