If you are going to make a purchase (budgeted or otherwise) for the church you are being asked to clear the purchase with one of our CFOs (Marie Hawley or Janelle Anders) or one of the Pastors (Lorrie Long, Nick Hartwig or Ron Ellis) to make sure we have sufficient funds for the purchase BEFORE the purchase is made and then a Check Request (forms available from the CFOs or the Mission Center office) needs to be filled out AFTER the purchase to receive reimbursement. This will help us keep better track of expenditures for budgeted items for the church. Thank you for your cooperation.

Gary Silver (Stu Silver's father) is coming to town with his stump remover within the next few weeks to remove stumps on the church property for free and is looking for jobs that will pay for his trip down from Boone. Gary charges \$2.00 per inch of diameter at the widest part of the stump and grinds down to a depth of 18 inches. If you have multiple stumps to be removed he said he could work a deal with you. If you are entirely certain that there are no buried cables or pipes within 18 inches of the surface then there is nothing else to do, but, if you are in doubt about buried utilities you will need to call "1 Call" at 1-800-292-8989 (Iowa) or 1-800-344-7483 (Missouri) and have the area marked before he comes down.
